### What is Hack KU?

### What is a Hackathon?

- ❖ A hackathon is a collaborative programming event where students can come together as a team to make their ideas a reality
- ❖ The goal for a hackathon is to produce usable software or hardware to be demonstrated to a panel of judges. Teams will be judged on a variety of categories, and the team with the best product will win a prize.

## Do students pay to attend Hack KU?

- ❖ Hack KU is completely free for college students, regardless of major.

## How many companies have sponsored Hack KU?

- ❖ Hack KU has been sponsored by a combined total of 30 companies.

## How many students participate in Hack KU?

- ❖ Traditionally we have had over 80 students sign up for the hackathon, however we are looking at a larger attendance rate this year (200+) as we are trying to become MLH certified. You can find more information about the MLH certification here: <https://mlh.io/about>

## How much does it cost to run an event of this scale?

- ❖ On average it will cost about \$14,000 to run a large scale event

## What are the rules / theme?

- ❖ The theme isn't released until right before the hackathon starts. The rulebook for Hack KU will be released soon.
